THE PURPOSE OF THIS NEWSLETTER IS TO INFORM YOU OF THE TOPICS YOUR CHILD WILL BE STUDYING FOR THE NEXT HALF TERM

Literacy

This half term, our text will be: 'The Lizzie and Belle Mysteries' by J.T Williams

The main areas of study will be:

- Biographies
- Character descriptions
- Letters
- Dialogue

Also, during literacy, your child will be focusing on sentence structure, grammar, spellings and handwriting.

Art and DT

This term children will be looking at mixed media. This project teaches children about paper crafts, paper making and collage techniques, including paper, fabric, mixed media and photo collage.

In DT we will be looking at moving mechanisms. This project teaches children about pneumatic systems.

Science

In Science we will be looking at materials and their properties. Wherever possible, we will be investigating these properties and looking at how these are used.

PE

Our PE lessons will be taught by our specialist PE teachers on a Thursday. These will focus on developing gymnastic skills so your child will need their PE kit of plain red shorts and plain white t-shirt.

Homework

Home work will be set each Friday on spag.com. This needs to be completed by the following Thursday.

Numeracy

Main areas of study:

- Multiplication
- Fractions
- Decimals
- Percentages
- Problem solving

Also, we will continue to focus on the quick recall of all of the times tables. Please encourage your child to continue to learn these at home too.

History and Geography

In History we will be learning about one of the first ancient civilisations, the Egyptians, looking at life and the achievements of Ancient Egyptians.

In Geography we will be learning about the features and characteristics of different types of agriculture in regions across the world.

Music

We are really excited to welcome Mrs Miller into our class this half term. She is a visiting music teacher from the Hull Music Service and will be teaching us how to make musical scores and compositions.

RE

During RE we will be looking at why the Torah is special for Jewish people.

Class Reading/Home Reading

Our class reading text is completing 'Odyssey' by Homer - followed by a non-fiction text 'Black and British: A Short Essential History.' Each week we will read a new chapter and complete comprehension questions.

Children will be given their home reading books to take home daily. They should be encouraged to read a few pages every night. Please discuss with your child what they have read before signing their reading record. Reading records need to be brought into school each day, so your child can progress on the class challenge of reading **5 times each week.**
